Brief Recap 2020-21

- COVID restrictions impacted all aspects of education
- Ultimately able to provide modified opportunities and experiences to students
- Expanded programming
- Budget, Reserves, and Fund Balance remain healthy



Looking Ahead:2021-22

ARP Funding

- \$1,015,810 (20% to learning loss/80% discretionary)-use by 9/30/24
- Summer Offerings (opportunities/experiences/learning loss)
- AIS Teacher, Enrichment Teacher, MSW/Counselor

Competitive Grant

- Extended School Day and Violence Prevention
- \$320,000 per year for 5 years = \$1.6 million
- (Applied months before we knew about ARP funds)
