
Grants Update

On Nov. 21, 2024, the second meeting of the Boquet Valley Central School District Facilities Committee was held. Committee members met with Facilitator Joe Dragone from Capital Region BOCES to review the outcomes from the first meeting in September, discuss state aid calculations, review the district's updated building condition survey and consider immediate priority repairs, Individuals representing BCA Architects & Engineers and SchoolHouse Construction Services LLC were also on hand to present and answer questions. How the committee plans to move forward was also discussed. The next meeting is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 17, at the Mountain View campus in Elizabethtown.

Rockefeller Institute Report

NYSSBA

- Praised the report's thoroughness and alignment with long-standing calls for formula improvements.
- Concerned about proposals to phase out "save harmless," which ensures no district receives less aid than the prior year.
- Highlighted risks of aid reductions without robust alternatives.

NYSCOSS

- Welcomed recommendations for addressing regional cost differences and updating poverty metrics.
- Supported increased equity in funding but expressed reservations about removing safety nets like "save harmless."
- Called for further analysis to prevent unintended consequences for rural and high-need districts.

Common Themes

- Broad agreement on updating outdated formulas to better reflect student needs.
- Shared concerns about potential disruptions in funding stability for certain districts.
