- The PK-12 program should be located on one site
- Thrall Dam site is off the table
- It is cost prohibitive to locate the PK-12 program at Lakeview

- Both projects include \$7.6 million for BCS (Site, Envelope, priority interiors, HVAC, Electrical and plumbing)
- The original Complete Option renovates and upgrades all aspects of the existing facility to approximate the condition of a new building (relocate below grade programs to ground
- level; equipment, finishes and furnishings would be replaced or refurbished etc. etc.)
- Low cost model provides for about \$2.9 million in classroom renovations TBD.
