## Dec. 17 Meeting Recap



The re-envisioned Boquet Valley Central School District Facilities Committee held a meeting on Dec. 17 to review work completed to date, explore updated options, discuss priority decisions and identify next steps.

#### Committee Decisions

- The PK-12 program (school) should be located on one site.
- The Thrall Dam site will not be used in any capacity.
- It is cost prohibitive to locate the PK-12 program at the Lake View Campus.
- The team will continue to evaluate parcels, including the four that were raised at this meeting, for siting a school.

#### Next Steps

- A program review will be presented. This will include the constraints that were used to determine the needs for the options that were previously proposed.
- Review a breakdown of what would be included in the full renovations at the Mountain View Campus (approximately \$25 million, as discussed).
- Review a breakdown of what would be included in limited renovations up to the Maximum Cost Allowance (MCA; \$15 million +/-) at the Mountain View Campus.
- Review a site sketch of locating transportation and the athletic fields at the Lake View Campus.
