



Parent Committee Members Needed:

Wellness, Health, and Safety: (meets annually in October —this year's meeting is 10/7 3:15-4:15) This committee is responsible for developing, implementing, and periodically reviewing and updating the district's wellness policy to promote student health and reduce childhood obesity. It addresses issues related to nutrition education, physical activity, and other school-based activities that promote student wellness and focuses on maintaining a healthy and safe school environment for students and staff.

District Safety- (meets annually in June): This committee is tasked with developing and annually reviewing the district-wide school safety plan to prevent and respond to emergencies. It assesses potential hazards, recommends safety measures, and coordinates with local law enforcement and emergency response agencies.

Shared Decision Making Committee- meets monthly-usually the 4th Thursday of the month, unless there is a holiday, then the 3rd Thursday of the month: As per New York State regulations, this committee develops and implements a plan for school-based planning and shared decision making. It brings together administrators, teachers, parents, and others to make collaborative decisions on various aspects of school operations and improvements. This year's major focus will be implementation of AI in the school district.
