



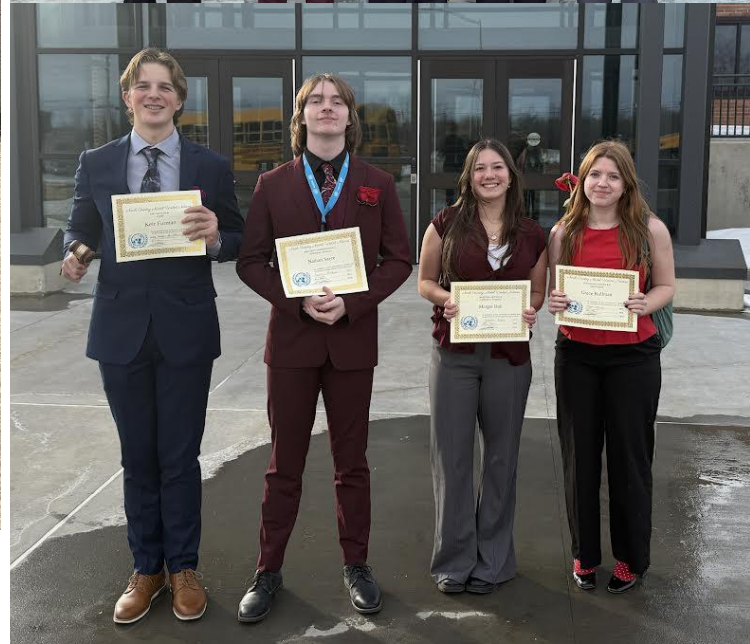

# Capital Project/EPC Update



- BCA back and forth with NYSED.
- Preliminary approval along with the **MCA** should follow from SED.
- EPC is ready to go (vote is only needed for additional 10% of aid)

# FC Recommendations



- 1. The Committee recommends that The Thrall Dam site should not be considered as a site for any future facility needs, and further, no viable property options currently exist for a new school site.**

# FC Recommendations



**2. The Committee recommends new construction and renovations at the Mountain View Campus to accommodate the PK-12 academic program (17 rooms PK-5, 3 Special Ed.)**

- a. Foundation repairs at the 1951 wing, masonry repair and repointing with replacement of damaged exterior panels, repair of expansion joints and flashing, replacement of exterior doors in the 1951 area, replacement of carpeting and VCT flooring with LVT in targeted areas, boiler replacement and upgrades to heating controls and pumping systems, replacement of unit ventilators and ventilation improvements in classrooms and bathrooms, new rooftop HVAC units and ductwork for the music room and auditorium, kitchen ventilation upgrades including new hood, exhaust, and make up air systems, replacement of cafeteria air handling system, kitchen plumbing upgrades including new sanitary piping and grease trap, replacement of ANSUL fire suppression system and safety upgrades in the chemistry lab, electrical upgrades including new circuits, fire alarm strobes, and carbon monoxide detection, improved building security including a hardened main entrance, visitor badging system, and a full security review with BOCES.**

# FC Recommendations



- 3. The committee recommends that Lake View Campus not be used for the transportation facility or the athletic fields**
  - a. Repurposing the site is very cost prohibitive**
  - b. Engage the municipalities in repurposing the site.**

# FC Recommendations



- 4. The Committee recommends further collaboration and partnership with Camp Dudley as the recommended location for athletic fields.**
  - a. Formalize the long history of collaboration**
  - b. Assess opportunities for improvements or expansion**

# FC Recommendations



- 5. The Committee recommends continuing to evaluate suitable properties for the construction of a new transportation facility.**
  - a. Location and cost considerations**

# FC Recommendations



Further, after an extensive review of the potential financial implications that construction and renovation will have on the school community, the Committee recommends that all construction and renovations at the Mountain View Campus consider the Maximum Cost Allowance to maximize aidable expenses.

Although the committee understands that the Maximum Cost Allowance will be exceeded based on the scale of necessary renovations, the Committee recommends every effort to balance the scope of the project with local tax impact.
